Intervention of rabbis and Jewish members of the Sejm regarding Jewish ritual slaughter

A delegation of Warsaw rabbis attended the Ministry of Enlightenment, requesting a meeting with Minister Świętosławski.

The Minister met with the representatives of the rabbinate, explaining that he could not accept their petitions regarding the introduction of changes to the proposed legislation on ritual slaughter which is to be published at

the end of this month. This was because it was only actual practice would show whether it would be advisable to make any changes to this regulation.

Regarding the same issue, a Jewish delegation consisting of Senator Trockenheim and lawyer Prylucki met with Industry and Trade Deputy Minister Sokolowski, where they received the same answer.

Professor from Mohammedan University in India a guest of the Hebrew University

On the way to England, Professor Samuel stopped in Jerusalem,

where he delivered a lecture (in English) at the Hebrew University. Prof. Samuel is an outstanding researcher in atomology.

On his way back, Prof. Samuel will spend a few weeks in Palestine and will possibly deliver a series of lectures, at the Hebrew University, on the topic of "Structures and Spectra of Molecules".

Jewish woman is Deputy Chairman Of the Moscow Soviet

ZAT: The well-known communist activist, Eugenia Kagan, has been elected as Deputy Chairman of the Moscow Soviet. This is first time that a woman has been elected to this position.

Eugenia Kagan has been a member of the Bolshevik party since 1907 and was arrested, many times, by the Tsarist authorities, for illegal

activities.

After the revolution, she held various responsible state positions.

For her outstanding achievements in promoting education amongst workers and peasants, she was recently awarded the Order of Lenin – the highest civilian award in the Soviet Union.

Death of a Jewish socialist activist

In Brooklyn, well-known socialist activist, Dr. Morris Schwarz, has died of a heart attack.

He especially dedicated himself to educational activities in the Jewish Arbeiter-Ring.

70th birthday of Richard Beer-Hofmann

A high-profile scandal, regarding the Central Crafts Fund in Lwów, has led to the arrest of the Fund's director, Franciszek Spineter. This concerns a fraud which is greater than 100,000 zł.

Following Dir. Spineter's arrest, another arrest followed which caused a huge sensation through the city. The President of the Lwów Chamber of Handicrafts and, recently Lwów candidate for the Sejm, Gustaw Pammer, was arrested.

At one time, the city was a shareholder in this fund to the value of 400,000 zł., however it withdrew this as it did not wish to have anything more to do with the Fund, the management of which raised a series of concerns.

He was Supervisory Board chairman of the Chamber. Pammer is director Spineter's brother-in-law. His arrest has become the talk of the town.
